WHAT ARE WE LEARNING?

We have finished learning our letters and letter sounds! We are working on blending the sounds together to make words. This month we will continue practicing our letter formation for all of the letters.

This month's sight words will be coming home on Mondays.

*We will be sending home a list of the sight words taught this month that your child has yet to master. Please practice these words at home, point them out together when you see them, and search for them in magazines and books.

Word lists will be coming home with words we are learning to read (and sound out). Please have your child practice reading these words to you at home. Continue to read the books from the book bags and discuss - reading to children greatly improves their comprehension skills.

This month in math, we will be working on non-standard forms of measurement, and work into addition and subtraction through 5 and then through 10.

In science and social studies, we will be exploring winter weather and learning about Martin Luther King Jr.
