




AVID Mission

The Hanover Insurance Group Foundation and Worcester Public Schools Partnership

- Organization: Purchased over 3,000 binders
- 2002 ~ 2017
- College Field Trips: Transportation for grades 4 12
- Scholarships: 14 students awarded \$2,000 each
- College Fair: 60 colleges participate, AVID/AP students attend annually
- Parent College Fair: 20 informational college parent sessions
- Service Learning: Train AVID teachers
- Teacher/Classroom Supplies: 86 teachers
- Professional Learning Opportunities:
 - Three-Day AVID Summer Institute, Philadelphia, PA
 - Two-Day Teacher Training in October (43 teachers)
 - AVID Curriculum Library for Teachers

The goal is to increase student achievement in content area classes by developing patterns and routines for problem solving and managing rigorous course work.










The AVID Tutor
