Procedure

RECORD ALERT FOR MISSING CHILDREN

Legislation requires that when the Police Department receives a report of a missing child, the following procedures should be implemented:

- 1. When the Police Department determines that a child is missing, they will notify the Office of the Deputy Superintendent of the Worcester Public Schools.
- 2. The Office of the Deputy Superintendent will immediately notify the school where the child is registered.
- 3. On the cumulative record of the missing student, the school will indicate with a Flag to the left of the student's name.
- 4. Any inquiry concerning a child whose record has been indicated with a Flag, will prompt school personnel to immediately notify the Office of the Deputy Superintendent.
- 5. The Office of the Deputy Superintendent will notify the Police Department.
- 6. When a missing child has been found, the school will be notified and the

Flag will be removed from the cumulative record.
