Preschool Application and Lottery:

> Application:

Beginning in January the district begins taking applications for our half-day preschool programs at the Parent Information Center 768 Main Street
Worcester, MA 01610
508-799-3194

- > Applications are collected at the PIC from January to March
- At the end of March principals receive applications for their preschool program, and principals make student selections through a lottery system.
- Principals send out acceptance or non-acceptance letters to parents. Acceptance Letters instruct patents to go to PIC and register their child. Non-acceptance letters instruct parents to call the PIC after Mid May for possible preschool openings within district. PIC also informs parents of other pre-school availability in the community.
- > Registration:

Parents of accepted students return back to the PIC to register their child for the school in which they received acceptance.

- When registering their child for Preschool they must bring:
 - Proof of child's date of birth
 - ❖ A current list of child's immunizations
 - Proof that child has been tested for lead paint poisoning
 - Proof of residency (utility bill, rent receipt, driver's license)

Note: Children must reside in Worcester and be four years old by December 31st to qualify for admission into the Worcester Public School Preschool program.
