The construction of a new Nelson Place Elementary School is scheduled to begin this summer. A Project Funding Agreement with the Massachusetts School Building Authority for this approved \$58 million project is contingent upon providing a site that will meet the Worcester Public Schools site program requirements. The City's responsibility is to secure properties necessary to meet these requirements.

The Worcester City Council voted on February 3 2015 and March 31, 2015 to approve an Order of Taking which included seven temporary easements one access easement five fee takings and one conveyance.

The conveyance, which is 1,373 square feet area of land, is to be conveyed to the abutters at 51 Nelson Place in exchange for land that this abutter will convey to the City as follows:

Parcel E Land of Jeanne R. Gauthier to City of Worcester

A certain parcel of land located southerly of Nelson Place in Worcester, Massachusetts, bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the northerly corner of the herein described parcel, said corner being S 13°24' 51" E, a distance of 142.84 feet along the easterly line of land now or formerly of Henry C. and Jeanne R. Gauthier from Nelson Place;

Thence continuing S 13_o 24' 51" E along land now or formerly of the City of Worcester, a distance of 62.27 feet along said easterly lot line of land now or formerly of Henry C. and Jeanne R. Gauthier;

Thence running S 89_o 37' 09" W continuing along said land now or formerly of the City of Worcester, a distance of 25.00 feet by the southerly line of land now or formerly of Henry C. and Jeanne R. Gauthier;

Thence running N 09₀ 51' 35" E, a distance of 61.64 feet to the Point of Beginning.

The above described parcel contains an area of 756 square feet, more or less, and is shown as Parcel E on the Plan.
