

The Worcester Public Schools USDA Summer Meal Programs 2015 has two summer trucks serving 20 sites throughout the city with free healthful meals to anyone under the age of 18 years commencing June 29, 2015 or soon thereafter until August 22, 2015.

Currently, the program is operating and serving meals within the framework of three USDA compliance structures: open to all 18 years or younger, homeless shelters under guidance from the Massachusetts Executive Office of Education (MEOE), one site for enrolled low-income summer programming participants.

Established partnerships with Worcester Parks and Recreation, Worcester Public Library, and MEOE have been maintained along with new youth program partnerships, an addition of 12 sites, established for summer 2015 to include/complement: Worcester Public Schools Academic Support Services afternoon programming in partnership with Worcester Parks and Recreation, City of Worcester Mobile Library, YMCA of Central Massachusetts Summer Camps, and Worcester Regional Environmental Council Farmer' Market.
