## **Strengthened PreK-K Transitions**

- Developed Worcester's Characteristics of Kindergarten Readiness: Transitioning from Preschool to Kindergarten - shared at state level as a model
- 2. Established "Meet & Greet with Principals" & common read for elementary principals
- Joint PD Family Engagement, Social-Emotional and Approaches to Plan & Learning, Early Learning WIDA, principal's high-quality Kindergarten, and ECE Leadership
- 4. Established community-school data working group







### **Created Characteristics of Kindergarten Readiness**

Community definition to anchor educators' work – common language, shared expectations









# Established Community-School Data Working Group

#### **Working Group's Purpose**


- To explore how Early Childhood Centers (ECCs) and the Worcester Public Schools (WPS) might collaborate so it is possible to:
  - Know which students in the WPS went to an ECC
  - Better understand the relationship between ECC participation and student outcomes
  - Share data with ECCs to inform programming and assess the effectiveness of services
  - Develop a system by which indicators of student readiness for school can be seamlessly shared with WPS school-based staff to maximize learning opportunities
- To better understand existing efforts at the state and national level
- To develop a strategic approach for proceeding in Worcester that is responsive to the needs of ECCs, the WPS and students.


