ITEM:

Response of the Administration to the request to consider having the summer reading kick-off within the schools during "Reading in our City Week" June 10 - 14.

ORIGINAL ITEM: Mr. Monfredo/Ms. Novick (April 16, 2013)

Request that the Administration consider having the summer reading kick-off within the schools during "Reading in our City Week" June 10 - 14. In addition, request that the Administration provide in a Friday Letter the District Summer School Plan to include the dates of summer school, the outreach to parents about summer reading and summer school, recruiting of students, attendance incentives, pre and post testing and partnerships within the community.

PRIOR ACTION:

BACKUP:

The Administration requested that all principals share with their students, staff, families and community partners that the summer reading kick-off program "Reading in our City Week" will be held during June 10th-14th. In addition, all students and families received copies of the 2013 summer reading lists and procedures for reporting back at the start of school. Three Connect-Ed messages were sent out over the summer months reminding students and families of the importance of reading and encouraging the completion of grade level reporting requirements.
