



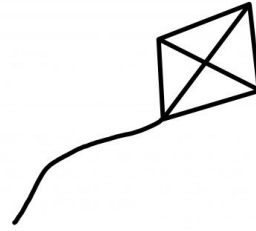
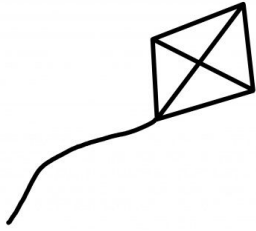
March Happenings in Grade 1-Mrs. Regele

Reading/Language Arts

We will continue to read different genre in reading. Students have been reading biographies and narrative non-fiction texts about Harriet Tubman, Rosa Parks, Helen Keller, Amelia Earhart and Sally Ride.

We will continue to meet in guided reading groups. Your child will have guided reading homework each night except for Fridays. Please make sure you look for it. The first night your child will have a reading assignment. The second night they will have a written assignment. If they are reading a chapter book they may have a written assignment each night. Your child has a guided reading homework calendar that needs to be signed by you each night. Your child's guided reading homework should be signed as well. I appreciate your cooperation with this.

We will continue to add 5 word wall words weekly. Please continue to have your child practice reading **all** of the word wall words nightly.



In Writing this month we will continue to work on Opinion Writing. The students are now able to complete a TREE Organizer and write a TREE using their organizer.

Mathematics

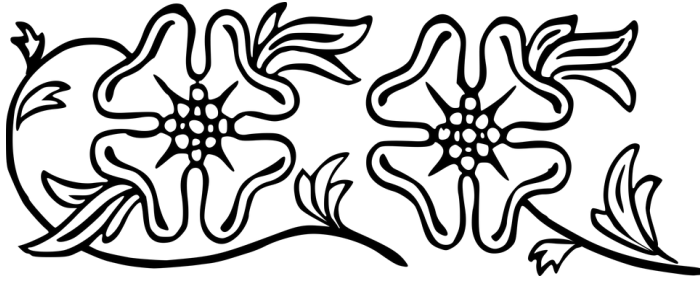
In Math this month we will finish up Topic 10 in our Envisions Math and move on to Topic 11. This topic deals with strategies for subtracting tens. Your child should be practicing the addition and subtraction facts to 20 nightly. It's important that your child knows these by June.

Social Studies

We will finish up our unit on Women in History. We will also learn about the holiday of Saint Patrick's Day and learn about Ireland.

Science

In Science this month we will continue to observe the weather and discuss the season of Spring. We will also begin a unit on animal adaptations. Students will discover each animal's diet, ecological role, habitat, and physical adaptations (structure and function) needed for survival.
