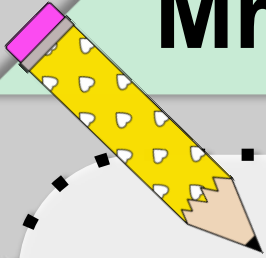


This month in: Mrs. Desimone's Class
