Look What We Are Learning!

Math: We will continue to study and convert units of measurement in the customary and metric systems. We will also read carefully and apply the four operations to solve word problems involving distances, intervals of time, liquid volumes, masses of objects, and money, including problems involving simple fractions or decimals, and problems that require expressing measurements given in a larger unit in terms of a smaller unit.

Science: We will continue to study and make observations to show that energy can be transferred from place to place by sound, light, heat, and electric currents.

ELA: This month, our focus is on Writing and keyboarding. We will continue to use the TIDE organizer and other strategies while we strengthen our typing skills. In addition to constructed responses, we will also be working on Narratives.
