Math: Students have begun a unit on Statistics and Probability; summarizing sets of data using measures of center and measures of variability. In addition, we are reviewing concepts taught earlier in the school year in preparation for the Math MCAS which will take place on May 21st and 22nd.

Science: Students are learning about forces of motion and their effect upon us. Later this month we will begin to study cells; parts and functions of plant and animal cells.

Our writing focus is narrative, but students will continue to write for a variety of purposes.
