THE NEW SOUTH HIGH DESIGN CLUB

South High Community School and Lamoureux Pagano Associates and Architects created a new after school club bringing an exciting opportunity for the students to participate in the design of their new school, scheduled to open in 2021. For the after school club, the students were presented with 5 design challenges that celebrate the school's rich history and South High's diverse community. Design Veritas's Created Impact, a social impact and design program has partnered with the school and architects to empower the students with a 21st century creative design process with invited speakers and local community collaborations. The New South High Design Club is an excellent opportunity to engage with the architects, learn 21st century design skills, and allow the students to leave their mark on the design of the new school lobby while inspiring future South High students for generations to come.

THE 5 CHALLENGES

1. Visual School Entrance Display - All About South High: Bring Your Culture to South High

This challenge is open for students to find the best way to showcase the school, themselves and their culture as part of a 2 D and 3-D display to be incorporated in the new school lobby entrance. The challenge is to find the best medium and format to display culture and the students, alumni, faculty that make up the rich diversity of South High's community through design.
