



Summer in the City with 21st Century

Our 21st Century summer programs were a great success! More than 100 middle school students participated in 21st Century programs at Burncoat Middle School, Sullivan Middle School and Claremont Academy from June through July. Our students participated in various project-based activities offered by Worcester Public School staff such as cooking, theater, arts, writing, and sports as well as engaging summer reading activities! In addition, we had the fortune of having various community partners provide activities including Learn to Lacrosse, FitGames and Conditioning offered by FitClub (*see pictures attached*); visual art, music, drama, dance and creative writing workshops offered by Main IDEA (*see pictures attached*); Adventure Challenge Experience (ACE) team building activities offered by You Inc.; a coding program offered by Worcester Polytechnic Institute; financial literacy activities by Country Bank; a nutrition and health education program offered by the UMASS Extension Nutrition Education Program, science and nature exploratory activities offered by MA Audubon Broad Meadow Brook, and an adventure sports program through Girls Inc.

Students were also provided with opportunities to engage in field trips such as meeting baseball players and viewing a Braveheart's baseball game at Fitton Field (*see pictures attached*); nature hike at MA Audubon Broad Meadow Brook, adventure ropes course at Cottage Hill Academy with You Inc., and a hands-on experience at the Regional Environmental Council Farm and the Community Harvest Project in Grafton. To wrap up summer activities, sites held

festive barbeques for students and families as a means to reminisce about the summer program as well as encourage participation in the upcoming school year 21st Century program.
