

Under the direction of the City Manager, the Superintendent and other members of the Administration are participating in a Homeless Youth Taskforce. With representatives from the City, state agencies and several social service organizations, the Administration has begun to dissect data around the variety of circumstances leading to homelessness of students and a variety of actions it might take to better meet their needs.

The Office of Social Emotional Learning is also undertaking a number of initiatives to provide direct support to homeless students and their families including installing additional washers and dryers at several school sites, providing direct assistance for food and clothing and ensuring that families are aware of all available services within and beyond the City of Worcester.
