Look What We Are Learning!

In MATH we are finding 1 x multi-digit products using traditional multiplication methods, expanded form, estimation strategies and area models. We will soon be finding partial products to solve 2 x 2 digit multiplication.

In SCIENCE we are learning about the Scientific Method and how to apply it to experiments by forming hypotheses and making detailed observations.

In ELA, we have finished the second quadrant of Shiloh, and the students are starting to receive letters back from the grown-ups they wrote to! The letters are thoughtful and truly show us how valuable it is to still communicate in a personal way during these digital times. We are building our knowledge of parts of speech and just added interjections and pronouns to our repertoire.
