

Massachusetts General Laws, Chapter 74, Section 14B, authorizes the School Committee to establish revolving funds for vocational programs. Revolving Funds are established to allow fees to be collected in connection with the operation of a program. The funds are used solely to support supplies and material purchases within the program. There are eight programs at Worcester Technical High School that have revolving funds (Skyline Bistro, Automotive Collision, Finance, Graphics, Carpentry, Horticulture, Cosmetology, and Machine Departments). The Automotive Program at South High Community School has requested the approval of a revolving fund to support fees collected from individuals for the repair and service of vehicles. Funds within the account be used for the purchase of tools and supplies to support the program.
