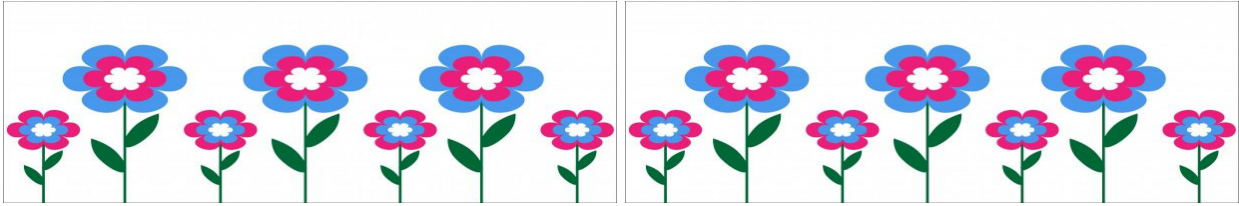


April's News

Math: Students have begun a Geometry unit this month. They are currently learning how to find the area of polygons using formulas. They will then learn how to apply this skill to find the surface area of rectangular and triangular prisms and pyramids.

Science: Mrs. Faiola’s homeroom has returned to Science this quarter. Life science is our focus as students learn about plant and animal cells and body systems. Next up, our focus will turn to physical science as students learn about the properties of materials. Students will be able to use the science materials for actual investigations, whether they are in-person or learning from home.

ELA: Students will begin a book study on [A Long Walk to Water](#) by Linda Sue Park. Students will continue to collect, interpret, and apply information through reading, discussion, and writing. Our writing focus is narrative, but students will continue to write for a variety of purposes. Please remind students to keep up with their book logs.

History & Social Science: Students will learn about the history, politics, geography, culture, economics, and social structures in Europe. Their final project will be a Google Slides presentation. For this project they will create a “My Trip” presentation. This will be a first hand account of what their virtual trip was like.
