ELA/Writing

- Phonics skills:
 - Short a,e,i,o,u
 - Verb Endings (-s,-ed,-ing)
 - o R clusters/blends (trip,grab etc.)
 - L clusters/blends (clock,flip etc.)
- Continue to practice sight words and build our word wall
- Continue practicing writing sentences and reflecting on our reading.

Math

- Fluently add and subtract within 10 (Part/Part/Whole)
- Addition facts to 20
 (Strategies such as doubles facts, doubles plus one and doubles plus two, think addition to subtract, and make ten to add are just a few)

*It is also very important that students practice addition and subtraction facts within 20.

Science/Social Studies

- Life Science: study of seeds, leaves, plants, trees, apples, and pumpkins. Study of bats and spiders.
- Study of the sun and moon.

- Continue to write about our science using the SRSD writing method (fact lists, TIDE charts, collaborative writes)
