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LEARNING OBJECTIVES

In **math** we have been working on the concepts of multiplication and division. We have used the equal group, number line, and the array model to help us. In October we will start memorizing our multiplication facts so that we can fluently solve problems in class.

We have been learning about the geography of Massachusetts in **Social Studies**. We will start to look at the first people who lived here many years ago.

In **reading** we continue to work on finding evidence in support our answers. We will be starting reading groups in October. Be sure to check in with students in a few weeks to see what they have been reading.

In **writing** we continue to work on writing a paragraph with a topic sentence, transition words, and an ending sentence. Our goal include evidence from the text and explain how it supports our main idea.
