Math: Students are beginning a new unit on Numeric and Algebraic Expressions. During this month, students will learn how to write and evaluate numerical and algebraic expressions, generate equivalent expressions and simplify algebraic expressions.

Science: Students will continue to use hands-on investigations to learn about Energy Waves and Information Transfer. Students will learn about the structure of waves, (sound, light and mechanical waves). Students will investigate how waves interact with surrounding materials and environments.
