OUR CLASSROOM NEWSLETTER LEARNING OBJECTIVES

In *math* we have been working hard at solving two step word problems using the CUBES strategy. We have been studying fractions, using a ruler to measure to the nearest ¼ inch, and making line plots. Later this month we will start looking at telling time and elapsed time.

In *reading* we just finished up the historical fiction novel <u>Glory Be</u>. Students will complete a book project to share their understanding of the story. We have also been studying folktales and fables. We will also begin studying poetry and figurative language during the month of April. Students will interpret and write their own similes, metaphors, and idioms.

In preparation for our field trip to Old Sturbridge Village we have been learning more about the Pilgrims and the Puritans. We have studied Puritan villages and will look closely at daily life for Puritans and hopefully make connections between our learning and what see during our field trip.

In writing we have been reading prompts to determine if we will write a narrative or an informational TIDE piece in preparation for MCAS. We will continue working on topic sentences and the best evidence to use in our writing.
