



We will begin to study rounding, addition and subtraction within 1,000, and move into our study of fractions by the end of the month. Students should continue to practice their multiplication and division facts to know them from memory. For science and social studies we will wrap up our study of magnets and move on to the study of the Pilgrim and the Puritans. Black History month will also be a focus as we read biographies and nonfiction texts.


