

OUR CLASSROOM NEWSLETTER LEARNING OBJECTIVES

In *math* we have been working on the relationship between multiplication and division. After studying the ways to use a multiplication table, we will start learning about finding area and perimeter of squares and rectangles. We even look at how to find the area of irregular shapes.

In **CKLA** we will wrap up our learning of Ancient Rome by writing a multi-paragraph essay sharing their thoughts about being a plebeian or a patrician child. They will learn many facts about Julius Caesar and the growth of the Roman Empire as well.

In *reading* we continue to practice finding facts and evidence to answer questions. We work on oral reading fluency at least 3 times per week to practice our abilities to effectively read out loud. Don't forget to keep reading books for pleasure at home!
